Feast Days and Memorials

June 11: St. Barnabas, Apostle, Martyr, d. 61

Patron of Cyprus, Antioch, against hailstorms, invoked as a peacemaker

Although his Hellenic Jewish parents had named him Joseph, according to the Book of Acts, the apostles called him Barnabas. He was a member of the early Christian community in Jerusalem, who sold the land that he owned and gave the proceeds to the community. He traveled as a missionary with St. Paul to Antioch and Cyprus. They were so violently opposed by the Jews that they decided to preach to the pagans, and converted a great many.

June 13: Anthony of Padua

Patron of Portugal, of the poor, and of lost articles

This saint is well known to all who call upon him to aid in finding something they have lost. Do you know who he was and why we direct those prayers of desperation to him? Fernando Martins was born to a wealthy family in Lisbon and became a devoted student of Scripture. He gained a reputation as a gifted speaker and preacher. Upon joining the newly formed Franciscan Order, he changed his name to Anthony. A precious book of psalms that he used to teach his fellow friars was stolen by a novice who left the hermitage. Anthony prayed that the book would be found and returned to him. The thief did return to the Order and brought his book back to him.

Glorious Saint Anthony, you have exercised the divine power to find what was lost.

*Help me to recover the grace of God, and make me zealous in the service of God
and in the practice of living the virtues.*

Let me find what I have lost, thus showing me the presence of your goodness.

(Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be)

*Anthony, glorious servant of God, famous for your merits and powerful miracles,
help us to find what was lost.*

Give us your help in times of temptation; and enlighten our minds in searching the will of God.

*Help us to find again the life of grace, which our sin destroyed,
and lead us to the possession of the glory promised us by the Savior.*
